



LACHLAN WAY, SANDGATE

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Lachlan Way, Sandgate has been closed to through traffic, on or after 6th May 2024 for up to 19 days.

The road has been closed at Lachlan Way, Sandgate.

The alternative route is via Sandgate High Street, Sandgate Hill, Lister Way and Castle Road.

In reverse Castle Road, The Riviera, Radnor Cliff, Radnor Cliff Crescent, Sandgate Hill and Sandgate High Street.

This closure is necessary to enable sewer repairs to be carried out by Southern Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
